i-Ready (available until August 7, 2020)

For students entering Grades 2 through 5, if you have taken the Diagnostic Tasks in Math & Reading, you now have an updated Learning Path! You can use your personalized Learning Path to bolster your skills!

If you haven't taken new Diagnostic tasks, you still may! Just know that your student will know 50% of the questions and will NOT know the other half. This is how their learning path is calibrated. It will likely take a couple of days to finish them, but at the end, your student will have a personalized path, just for them

Zearn

All students will have access to Zearn via their Clever account. Each student's Zearn account will be set for the Zearn Math Summer Recovery Program. This program is a shortened Zearn program that highlights critical math skills from the grade your child was promoted from. This program can be done digitally on Zearn or can be done using the paper packets below.

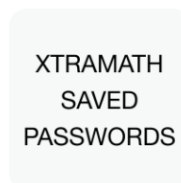
