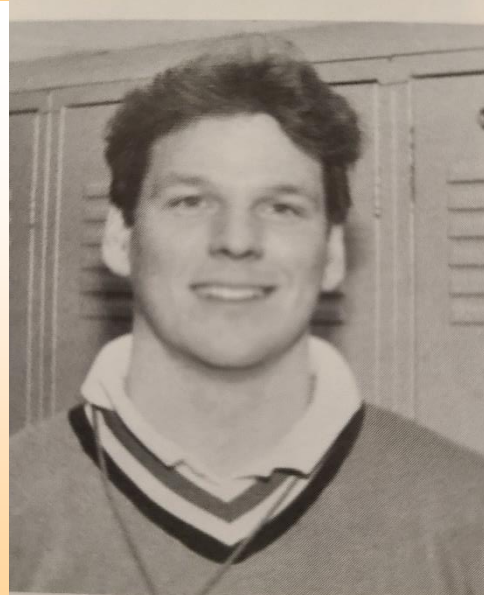


Principal's Message

PowerSchool / Parent Portal Reminder

Please note that for the middle school, Parent Portal is reflecting the “regular” schedule and not the “cohort or virtual” schedule that we are currently following. This means, the period order and teachers may be different from the current schedule that the students are following during cohort or virtual learning. It is necessary to keep the original master schedule in PowerSchool in the event that we eventually return to the regular schedule. Therefore, student grades for cohort learning will be kept on Google Classroom. Overall averages will be transferred/updated to PowerSchool on a weekly basis. The first update occurred on Wednesday, September 30th in the afternoon. Parents will have the ability to view individual assignments and grades on their child’s Google Classroom pages by utilizing the student’s username and password to gain access. Once you are logged into the page you will click on the Classwork tab and then click “View Your Work”. If you are unsure of your child’s username and/or password you can contact the office and we will provide the information to you. Our teaching staff will continue to be in contact with parents about grades and please never hesitate to reach out to us if you have questions about academic performance. It is our goal to keep you informed of your child’s progress as we work through this new reporting process.
