The DIBELS-8:

An overview of early identification and monitoring strategies used by elementary reading teachers in the Pompton Lakes Elementary Schools

WHAT ARE THE DIBELS?

- The Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) are a series of early literacy measures that are compiled to determine a child's risk profile for reading difficulties or indicators of dyslexia (CTL: University of Oregon, 2022).
- Lincoln and Lenox Elementary schools adopted this set of assessments as a Universal Screener in September 2022.

THREE USES FOR THE DIBELS

Identifying for Support (TSS)

The DIBELS Universal Screener our district's biggest indicator that a child needs more support.

Progress Monitoring

When a child receives additional support, their progress must be closely monitored to ensure the interventions are working.

Screening for Dyslexia


The DIBELS serves as an approved Dyslexia screener in New Jersey because it tests:

- Phonological Awareness
- Rapid Automatized Naming
- Alphabetic Principle
- Word Reading

TIERED SYSTEMS OF SUPPORTS (TSS)

- If a child's DIBELS score places them into the "Intensive Support" category, they will receive TSS in Reading.
 - Intervention & Enrichment Period: Pull-out structured literacy lessons
 - Cardinal Academy

INTERVENTION & ENRICHMENT PERIOD

K-5

Each grade level has a different period.

Specialists can service every grade level every

day.

Each period is 40 minutes long.

These daily 40 minutes can be used for:

- -Pull out instruction
- -Push in, small group instruction
- -Gifted & Talented
- -ESL support
- -Academic support (IEP)

CARDINAL ACADEMY

K-8

Any student invited to Cardinal Academy (for reading) is a Tier 3 student in reading.

The skills addressed during intervention times come from deficits in the child's DIBELS score.

How Do We Know That These Interventions Are Working?

Reading Specialists, Cardinal Academy Teachers and classroom teachers use the DIBELS for progress monitoring with select students.

 "Progress monitoring, which involves regularly assessing student performance through brief assessments, is used to determine students' rate of improvement or response to intervention and to evaluate the effectiveness of instruction" (NJTSS).


How the student performs on these assessments is considered their "Response to Intervention"


SECOND GRADERS' SCORE COMPARISON

GOING FORWARD...

- Adopting the DIBELS as a Universal Screener has allowed us to identify the students who are most at risk.
- We are now able to accurately monitor their progress and see if they need more support.

Next year, we are adopting mCLASS a digital platform that organizes students' DIBELS scores and makes recommendations for what interventions students need. We will continue to evaluate the effectiveness of these assessments, and continue to monitor student progress using the individual progress monitoring assessments.

In February, we're adopting Learning Ally, which is a form of assistive technology that will offer a variety of human-read audiobooks. Learning Ally can highlight the text as it's read aloud.
