TCS Testing – 7th Grade

On Thursday, February 28th, the seventh grade students will be taking the Test of Cognitive Skills (TCS). This assessment is administered in the fourth and seventh grade and is designed to measure skills that are important for academic success. It features scores for three learning components: verbal, nonverbal, and memory. In short, this assessment measures the student's IQ.
